### 1. Chateau Near Paris

Rooms: 53

Building floor area: 5,172 m<sup>2</sup>

Land area: 60 hectares



The Château purchased in 1981, offers a fine example of Renaissance architecture, with towers, turrets, balconies, bell-turrets and French gardens. It is located not far from Paris, between Rambouillet and Chartres, in the middle of a 60-hectare classified park with many rare and beautiful trees.

Château an 18th century style castle built by perfume-maker François Coty, was purchased in 1962. It is located in the valley of Indre, south of Tours on a 25-hectare estate.

Château offers an exceptional decor that includes fine woodwork, trompe-l'oeil frescos and top luxury furnishings. It is also the largest hotel of it's category in the Loire valley region.



Château is a majestic and elegant castle famous for its stunning landscaped gardens and magnificent architecture. With a vast array of activities and facilities available, from golf and fishing to Jacuzzis and saunas, you're guaranteed a memorable break.

As it vies with the great châteaux of the Loire, who would guess that Château is a 20th-century tribute to a penniless Corsican orphan who went onto become a newspaper proprietor, politician and parfumier. His name was François Coty, and it is sad that he never lived to see his concept completed. Its extravagance belongs to an earlier age.

The château was always intended as a palace of indulgence; and so it is, with a 65-acre estate, formal gardens, opulent drawing and dining rooms, gourmet food, palatial bedrooms, and cellars containing over 20,000 wines mainly from the Loire region.



### 3. Hotel near Amboise

Building floor area: 2,303 m<sup>2</sup> Land area: 4 hectares

### Hotel 32 rooms in three residences, including:

- 28 individual rooms
- 4 suites.



Located near the city of Amboise, purchased in 1985, is a group of three residences built in the 16th and 17th centuries: Maison de l'Ermite, Maison du Duc et Maison de l'Apothicaire.

Sitting between the Loire river and Italian-style terrace gardens bordering troglodyte cave-homes, Le Choiseul offers the peaceful family-type setting of a country home.

#### Art exhibitions

"Les Greniers de César" – a group of four former troglodyte silos covering four levels – hosts a variety of painting and sculpture exhibitions. This site was classified as a historic monument in 1947.

Built in 1973, a large country house in the French southern Mediterranean style that has earned a world-wide reputation. Located in an 8-hectare pine forest across from the village walls of Saint-Paul de Vence, between Nice and Antibes, it is less than 15 minutes from the international Nice Côte d'Azur airport. A truly unique establishment with 25 private swimming pools, junior suites with terrace, full suites with patio, and separate villas located in the gardens.

It offers it's largely international clientele a magnificent view of Mont Blanc.

### 7. Château in Alsace, near Colmar

41 rooms including 1 suite, with view of the Vosgian Forest, local villages and vineyards. All rooms are decorated with historic furniture styles and fine fabrics.

- The Dagobert room, built in the 14th century with vaulted ceiling accommodating 50 people for private dining






### 8. Château near Strasbourg


